Both pairs suffered from the absence of the increasingly popular Reverse Flannery two-heart response, which indicates a moderate hand with five spades and at least four hearts. The Easts tried to cope with a doomsday scenario in different ways.

Pratap hoped that either he would hit five-five opposite or that taking any further action would turn out to be worse than passing.

Sanborn created a force, but then violated it by passing three diamonds. We're not sure why McCallum did not bid two notrump at her third turn, and it is not clear whether a three-heart continuation by East would then have been forcing. McCallum claims that she would have responded with an offbeat one heart but concedes that a two-club rebid by West would then have led to an even worse problem. Still, one heart would work spectacularly if West were to raise to two.

BWS Auction: $1 \diamondsuit - 1 \spadesuit - 2 \clubsuit - 2 \heartsuit - 2 \text{ NT-3} \heartsuit - \text{Pass (or } 4 \heartsuit).$

It's surprising that the usually gressive McCallum did not open bidding, but that decision allowed to bid aggressively later, and Sanbothree diamonds provided the impetoreach game. The Newcomers gair four matchpoints and were just a points behind with two deals remaing.
